Greetings to you in the name of our Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ from Grace Academy, India!

The New Academic Session (2021-22) after summer vacations started smoothly in July 2021 and all our students & staff are doing well.

Some of the residential students who came in April 2021, to appear for the Board Practical Exams (Public Exams) of Class X & XII suffered from Covid-19 virus. We isolated the entire residential block along with the Dorm Mother, a Care Taker and a Cook. The other students who were tested negative were sent back home. The Practical Exam of Class XII was postponed. The students were constantly under the supervision of a doctor during their recovery from Covid-19 virus. The local authorities were informed and they came for the inspection and sealed the affected area. By the grace of God, all the students recovered soon from their sickness and returned home safely. One of our school parent came forward to pay for the expenses incurred in the treatment of these students. We marvel at the provisions our Lord provided from His bounty during this time.

This year some of our colleagues and students lost their loved ones in their family due to Covid-19 virus. A Parent of our School student extended a helping hand and provided financially for few students who lost the bread winner of the family, to pay for their fees. The school has given full scholarship to all such students whose earning member in their family died due to this pandemic.

This year too we are struggling to receive monthly Tuition fees from the school parents, still Lord is providing the needs of the school in amazing ways.

As mentioned in our previous letter, regarding the postponement of the CBSE Board Exams (Public Exams) of Classes X & XII, it was later cancelled for this year and the result was declared based on the Internal Assessments Conducted by the School.

In August, we welcomed our school students in school from Classes VI-XII, after the State Government allowed the schools to be opened for physical Classes, only upon the consent of the parents. Once again we felt like the school is alive and breathing when the students started to attend physical classes. In the beginning the attendance of the students was very low but gradually the attendance of the students coming to school increased. We were happy to see our students after more than a year. Some were difficult to recognise as they grew tall.



Orientation for new parents








